

10. That the management of the school will obtain from the DDA in the name of the Society through the Director of Education, Delhi.

11. That the school shall run under the control of Little Angels Public School Society (Regd), Delhi and will make efforts for the school site on the recommendation of the Director of Education and will construct and appropriate building within the three years of taking over of the site from the DDA and adequate and sufficient accommodation of 12 sq.ft. per student shall be provided for class-rooms. Normal size of the class-room is 24'x30'. No other activity other than education shall be run.

If recognition for the proposed school is not granted after fulfilling all the above conditions within a period of 3 years, this permission to run a new school shall be treated as cancelled.

With reference to your application on the subject
mentioned above, I am directed to convey the permission of the
Board of Education, Delhi, to your Society to run a new middle
school in the A-10, V.I.I. (Suburban) in Punjabi Wara Area
Delhi, subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the provisions of the DSEA, 1973 and the rules
and the order shall be observed by the Society.

2. That the management of the school will fulfil all the
conditions laid down under Rule 50 and will provide all
the facilities given in Rule 51 of the DSEA, 1973 to the
Board of Education.

3. That the management of the school will get the scheme of
work approved from the department immediately.

4. That only qualified and trained teachers will be appointed
and their salaries along with allowances will be paid
to the teachers and non-teaching staff through crossed cheques.

5. That the management of the school will not ask for
grant-in-aid from the department.

6. That the school will not be for the profit of any
individual or association or group of persons.

7. That the school is to be run at any time the management of the school
is unable to run the school, movable and non-movable property
of the school will be transferred to the care of the Director
of Education, Delhi.

8. That the management of the school will apply for
grant of recognition of the school under DSEA and Rules, 1973
immediately and recognition will not be granted unless statutory
provisions of Section 4 (e) to (f) read with rules 50 and 51
are complied with.

9. That all the recognised classes shall be run at one
place only.
