SOCIAL SCIENCE

1. Interdisciplinary Project

Storyboarding “Forest Society and Colonialism”

Students must create a 6-8 panel storyboard on A3 or A4 sheets to illustrate key themes from the chapter, promoting neatness, accuracy, and originality.

Project Objectives:-

Develop understanding of colonial forest policies’ impact on Indian and global societies through sequential visuals. Integrate facts like the Indian Forest Act (1878), tribal rebellions, and ecological changes. Submit by the end of winter break with a self-assessment note on challenges faced.

Materials Required:-

- Plain sheets
- Pencils, erasers, colored pencils/markers/crayons (watercolors optional).
- Ruler for neat borders; textbook for references.

Preparation Steps:-

1. Read Chapter 4 thoroughly, noting events like commercial forestry, shifting cultivation bans, and resistances (e.g., Bastar Rebellion led by Gunda Dhur).
2. Outline 6-8 panels in a storyboard grid: sketch thumbnails first.
3. Draw main scenes with labels, captions (2-3 lines each), and textbook quotes in speech bubbles.
4. Color consistently (e.g., green for forests, red for conflict); ensure legible handwriting.
5. Add title page: “Forest Society and Colonialism Storyboard” with name, class, roll no., and date.

Suggested Storyboard Ideas:-

Theme 1: Timeline of Change

Panels: (1) Pre-colonial forests with tribals; (2) British arrival/logging; (3) Forest reserves creation; (4) Tribal displacement; (5) Songram Sangma's rebellion; (6) Modern forest management.

Theme 2: India vs. Java Comparison

Split panels showing Dutch shipbuilding vs. British railways, both restricting nomads like the Oraons or Kalangs.

Theme 3: Rebellion Focus

Sequence: Colonial officers marking trees, Gunda Dhur's call, attacks on police stations, partial British withdrawal.

2. Art Integration – Compare the latitude, longitude physical features, Water Resources, Natural Vegetation and wild life of Andaman and Nicobar, Delhi and Lakshadweep Islands'

MATHEMATICS

1. Make portfolio based on any one of the topics

- (a) Quadrilateral, types of quadrilateral with their properties and theorem based on quadrilaterals
- (b) Polynomials and types of algebraic identities
- (c) Types of triangles, properties of triangles and use of Heron's formula to find area of triangles
- (d) Circle, parts of circle and theorems based on circle.

Portfolio should be minimum of 15 pages having cover page, acknowledgement, index introduction and detail explanation of the topic

Island with Delhi in terms of their area, their population and climatic differences using different types of graphs
